19 plaintiff Candace Conti, and against defendant Jonathan Kendrick, severally, in the amount of
20 \$4,122,000.00;

22 favor of plaintiff Candace Conti, and against defendants Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New
23 York, Inc., North Fremont Congregation, and Jonathan Kendrick, jointly and severally, in the amount of
24 \$30,199.58;
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
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Plaintiff is further awarded post judgment interest as allowed by law.
