We explained the Society's policy of confidentiality and directed the elders to contact the Legal Department if they are subposenced. We had no legal objection to the elders handling this matter as they would any other case of serious wrongdoing. The elders should refer to the Awake! issues on child abuse (6-2-3-2, 1-2-2-85, 1-2-2-86, 10-1-83) in giving appropriate spiritual assistance to the family. Positive steps should be taken to prevent further abuse. The elders should monitor the situation carefully for the protection of other potential victims.	The elders have a duty to report child abuse under the child abuse reporting law. They should speak to the offender directly and find out if he is wrilling to turn himself at. If he is unwilling, there may be someone else who has knowledge of the abuse who will make a report. If no one who has knowledge of the abuse is willing to make a report, two elders should make an excorpingous phone report from a neutral location, such as a phone booth. They should keep a written record of who made the call, to whom it was made, the date and time of the call, and other pertinent factors. This record should then be signed by the two elders and placed in congregation files as proof that a report of child abuse was made in complame with the law. We explained the Society's policy of confidentiality and directed the elders in contact the Legal Department if they are subponned. We had no legal objection to the elders handling this manter as they would any other case of senious wrongdoing.
